1. Introduction

The purpose of this report is to provide an update to the CCG regarding the status of primary medical care contracts in the CCG area for the period March 2019 to September 2019.

2. Contract number, type and list size

As at September 2019 there are currently 39 practices in the Cumbria CCG area. 36 are GMS contracts, 1 is a PMS agreement and 2 are APMS contracts. There are no changes to the number of practices since the last report.

**The current Fellview APMS contract is due to expire on 30 September 2019, following a successful procurement, a new contract is currently being mobilised which will commence on 1 October 2019 and expire on 30 September 2027.*

3. Directed Enhanced Services Sign-up

2019/20 – Sign up

A summary of the Directed Enhanced Services that Practices' have signed-up to (YES) or declined (NO) for 2019/20 is shown in **Appendix 1**.

Special Allocation Scheme

Commissioner are responsible for ensuring patients who have been removed from their practice due to violent or threatening behaviour continue to have access to primary

care services through the commissioning of a Special Allocation Scheme (previously called the Violent Patient Scheme). Where possible, the Special Allocation Scheme (SAS) DES is commissioned from one or more practices for all patients within the CCG area. However, where this is not possible, this service can be commissioned from a practice outside of the CCG area. All patients on the scheme receive an annual review to determine whether they should remain on the register or be discharged back to general practice.

Details for the schemes in the North Cumbria CCG area, including updated figures from the previous baseline report can be found below; (Please note these figures are based at a point in time, PCSE are in the process of carrying out a national reconciliation of patients registered on SAS schemes, therefore the final figures may vary going forward).

*The SAS scheme currently provided as part of the Fellview APMS contract will expire on 30 September 2019, the CCG is currently exploring several commissioning options, however the new provider has agreed to continue delivery of the SAS scheme on a short-term temporary basis.

**Oxford Street Surgery has submitted a six-month termination notice to cease provision of the SAS scheme and therefore the service will end on 20 February 2020. The CCG have been informed and discussions are ongoing with the provider whilst the CCG explore commissioning options.

4. Business Cases and Performance

a) List Closures

As of July 2019, all practices in the Copeland area have now opened their list for new patient registrations following previous approval in December 2018.

Eden Medical Group currently has a closed list; however this is due to reopen on 10 October 2019.

There are no pending applications from practices to close their list.

b) Mergers

No applications for practice mergers have been received since the last report.

d) Boundary Changes

There has not been any change to the practice boundaries since the last report. Upper Eden Medical Practice are currently engaging with patients about a boundary change. The report is expected to be presented to North Cumbria PCCC in October, however this is dependent on receipt of application and conclusion of engagement.

e) Dispensing Practices

Patients who live in rural areas and where there is no accessible pharmacy may apply to a GP practice to receive pharmacy or dispensing services; this means that the patient is able to receive their medication directly from the GP practice. A GP practice does not have to deliver dispensing services if they do not wish to or if they don't have staff with the necessary training or skills.

Dispensing practices are also given the opportunity on an annual basis to sign up to deliver the Dispensary Services Quality Scheme (DSQS) which is a scheme that financially rewards dispensing practices for meeting specific criteria.

There are 16 dispensing practices in the CCG area. The following table shows dispensing practices, the number of dispensing patients and if the practice has signed up to deliver the Dispensary Services Quality Scheme in this financial year.

f) Premises

There are no current applications for a change of premises location.

g) Quality Outcomes Framework [QOF] 2018/19

QOF is a voluntary annual reward and incentive programme available to all GP surgeries detailing practice achievement results. QOF for 2018/19 consisted of the following domains;

- Clinical - 65 indicators across 19 domains (e.g. chronic kidney disease, heart failure and hypertension), worth a maximum of 435 points.

- Public Health – 12 indicators across 6 clinical areas (e.g. blood pressure, obesity, smoking, cervical screening and contraception), worth a maximum of 124 points).

All practices have signed up to QOF. **Appendix 2** provides information on QOF achievement for 2018/19. Overall QOF achievement for the year is published nationally in September.
