

The NHS in north Cumbria is already ahead of some other parts of the country in terms of integrating services to support staff work around the needs of the patient more easily.

We have already established eight Integrated Care Communities that have rapid response hubs, staffed by primary care, social care and community teams supporting people who are medically fit to get home from hospital but may need extra support, as well as supporting people to stay well enough to avoid being admitted unnecessarily.

Future plans include the development of the Cancer Centre and the redevelopment of the West Cumberland Hospital, as well as a focus on creating a great place to work.
